From the Pastor: Hi Parish Family Members of OLOS, I have been looking forward to working with you all doing different ministries for the good and growth of the Parish. I consider Parish is a community of faithful forming a family unit within the diocese and the Church. When Peter pronounced his faith in Jesus Christ, He said to him, 'you are Peter on which I will build my church. Jesus is really and truly building His church locally and universally and we part of this very process. I consider myself a guest in the parish family. I would be here for a while and then I would be gone. This has been the pattern of the church's functioning. In this period of priestly service, every new priest brings in his charisms and infuses newness into different ministries and that keeps the parish growing in all aspects so as to become a vibrant parish.
