I would like to remind all the teachers and sub - teachers (Catechists) of PSR program and of youth ministry to attend the proposed training program by John DeLaporte, the Diocesan Coordinator of Youth Ministry scheduled for August 6, Monday from 6.30 to 8.30 pm at Sacred Heart Church, Eldon Catholic Centre. It will be a joint program with the group of Eldon. It is an important program designed to guide our younger generation in their faith journey. I would not like anyone to miss out of this great program. Perhaps you have already got emails about it. If anyone else is interested in attending it, he/she is most welcome.

As an ongoing catechesis, I would like to bring to the attention of all those who do liturgical ministries both at weekdays and weekend Masses – such as Mass coordinators, lectors, communion ministers and servers to dress in pants and shirts. Because they are doing special ministries at Mass. And so, they have to be moderate in their dresses lest the attention of others at Mass should be driven away.

From the Bishop:

Pro-Life Novena of Weeks Prayer Campaign

I invite you and your parishioners to join me and Catholics nationwide in a weekly moment of prayer from early August to late September 2018 for the legal protection of human life. As soon as Supreme Court Justice Anthony Kennedy announced his retirement, pro-abortion groups began lobbying the U.S. Senate to reject any nominee who does not promise to endorse *Roe v. Wade*. We should certainly raise grave concerns about a confirmation process that is being grossly distorted by efforts to subject judicial nominees to a litmus test of support for abortion. And we must pray. Each Friday, from August 3 to September 28, 2018, we'll have the opportunity to join in a nine-week effort of prayer, fasting and education that a change in the U.S. Supreme Court will move our nation closer to the day when every human being is protected in law and welcomed in life.

As part of the USCCB Call to Prayer, participants can receive weekly prayer reminders by text message or email. In addition to the current invitation to fast on Fridays, participants will be encouraged to pray one Our Father, Hail Mary, and Glory Be for this intention and will receive important facts about how *Roe* is not health care, is bad law, and fails women. Please also consider sharing the intention, graphics, and facts about *Roe* in your parish bulletin, on your website, and in other parish communications throughout this nine-week period. The U.S. bishops urge our participation each Friday in a nationwide Novena for the Legal Protection of Human Life, August 3–September 28.
