## From the Pastor: Greetings from India!

I thought that I would share some news with you all through an email. First of all, I want to tell you that by the grace of God, I had a safe and pleasant air travel to India. It took nearly 22 hours to get here. I got home on August 18th, Saturday at 6 am. My older brother was at the airport to receive me. Now, due to time difference, I am not getting sleep - when everyone is asleep I am awake but when everyone is awake, I am asleep. Perhaps you would know that India is 12.30 hours ahead of US. It will take a couple of days to get on to the sleeping cycle with the change of time.

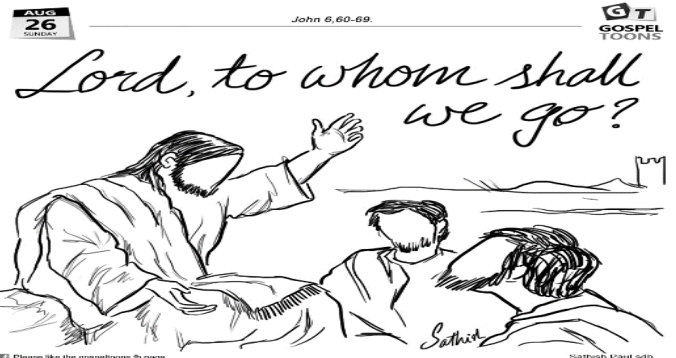
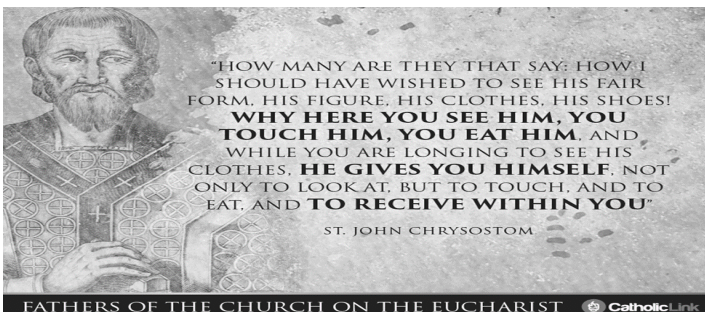
On August 19th, Sunday, I joined the Mass at my home parish church dedicated to St. Joseph. We had two guest priests to offer Mass and preach homily. They were here to make an appeal for a new church they intend to build in their parish. They did get a good collection. Maybe, you will be surprised to learn that the Sunday Mass started at 7.10 am and ended at 9 am. As usual, it had a lot of singing. The main celebrant also sang the prayer of consecration and added his own personal spontaneous prayers at different moments of the Mass. The announcements were quite lengthy done after the last prayers as they do not have parish bulletin. I do admire the people here for being so patient. It might be news to you that people do not have pews in the church but they have only bare floor facility. However, the elderly have been provided benches at the back of the church.

We were three priests and two nuns distributed Holy Communion that went for 15 minutes. It would have been lengthy if we had the children. Because, the Pastor celebrated Mass for them separately in a hall as it is done once a month. Here everyone from Pre- K to college attends the Sunday catechism and there is no exception for anyone whether they go to catholic schools or public schools. It is a compulsory Sunday program before Mass. Here the weekday Mass is at 6 am and the working people attend in good number.

Perhaps, you have read in the news that Kerala, a state in South India where Apostle St. Thomas landed in 52 AD is under flood water. Due to torrential and incessant rain for over a week, the major dams got overfilled with water and so the authorities decided to open the floodgates. It resulted in flooding of standing crops and plantation while inundating the houses of people in most places in the state. It is estimated over half a million have been displaced and over a few hundreds have died. The Air, Rail and Bus services have been suspended for a couple of weeks now in main cities. The military and navy have been pressed into action to rescue the people who have been trapped in the flood water. The engagement of my cousin brother's daughter which I was supposed to attend on August 22nd got cancelled due to the flooding of boy's village. We do not have a good weather forecast as we have in US. Please offer special prayers for the affected people that they may be given timely relief and necessary assistance by government authorities, volunteers and people of good will. My home district, Kanyakumari which is adjacent to Kerala is also experiencing the effect of rain as it is monsoon season all over India. It is a clear sign of climate change.
