From the Pastor: Last Sunday Mass, September 9th was well attended. I appreciate you all for your kind gesture. After Mass, the junior group had a kick off program for the PSR school year. I thank all the teachers, the PSR and Youth Coordinators for being present and get the process started interacting with the parents who showed up. Now, I request those parents who could not be present to get their kids enrolled for the said program to do it by the start of regular classes. I would not like any of our kids be deprived of this God-given opportunity to grow strong in faith.
