From the Pastor:

On November 25, we are celebrating the feast of Christ the King that will be the last Sunday of the Liturgical year 2018. With Advent first Sunday, the new liturgical year C will begin.

This year, we have planned a couple of special activities to make the Christmas celebration more meaningful. On the first weekend of Advent after Mass, each family is requested to pick up a **rolled up piece of paper** from the ushers that would have name and address of a member family of our Parish. Then, you are requested to pray for that person/family without letting them know about it, during the advent season. Just after third Sunday of Advent, you are requested to send a Christmas card to that person/family you have prayed for. In the card, please write and say **‘I have prayed for you & your family and many Christmas & new year blessings**. Or you may use your own wordings but the sentence ‘I have prayed for you and your family’ must be written. Only when receiving a card, that person/family would know that you have prayed for them. It is a wonderful gesture of families praying together and praying for each other during advent to be prepared for Christmas as a parish community. It would also create family bond through prayer. It might happen that there would be some rolled up papers left, then, please do not hesitate to take one extra to pray for and you would have double blessings.

As before, the second activity is that there will be a **Christmas tree put up** at the back of the Church called **‘giving tree’**. On its branches, you will find tags with numbers and list of needs. Each number would have an anonymous family attached and the needs will be the things that family members expressed as Christmas gift. You are requested to pick up a tag and provide the items that are mentioned in it. By third Sunday of Advent, place the requested things in a good wrapping or bag at the foot of the tree and keep your name anonymous. It could be one person /family or two providing for one number. The purpose of this kind of giving is to reach out to those families who are really and truly in dire need of some basic things to keep themselves going in life. They could be of any families within and outside the Parish. I would greatly appreciate people come forward and support this noble program of our parish. This would be the most pleasing gift that Jesus would love on His birthday. Melissa Koetting is the coordinator of this program you may contact her or the parish office any families in mind that could be helped.

Santa Shop is a wonderful program for our school kids scheduled for December 18. It would bring in a lot of joy to our kids when they are able to shop the things they would like to have for Christmas. Here is a call for all parents to think of our kids and fill in the shops with things they would generally love. It is also time to educate them to share things with others who do not have such opportunities.

I have given **Mass Schedules and Penance Services for December - New Year** as bulletin insert. This time penance services will be held separately for the school kids as well as PSR kids from 2nd – 6th grades and 7th- 12 grades. The teachers will prepare their kids in their respective classes. They need to learn the basic steps towards making a good confession. It needs practice. And also, they will have to be guided to do the examination of conscience well. For this, materials are being prepared by our school. The PSR and Confirmation Coordinators may kindly contact the Principal or school office to obtain the necessary copies of the material. For all parishioners, the penance service will be held on December 12th Wednesday at 7 pm. We all as a parish family need spiritual preparation to experience the joy and peace of Christmas.
