From the Pastor:

Appreciation and thanks: In spite of inclement weather, the last weekend Mass attendance was pretty good. I appreciate all those who attended Mass so much for taking trouble to be at Mass to celebrate the baptism of our Lord. I thank Barb Adrian and Alan Berendzen for giving me a ride on Saturday evening to come over to offer Mass and Sunday morning return after Mass.

Diocesan CSA Campaign: Every year, our Diocese makes Catholic Stewardship Appeal to all the Parishes seeking support for the common ministries of the Diocese. For the year 2019, our Parish has been given a goal of \$ 13,000.00 and as of today only \$10,058.00 has been turned in. It means that we have covered only 77 per cent of the given goal. It is our annual contribution toward the diocesan ministries meant to support parish ministries in the diocese. Nevertheless, we can never forget the great favor that the diocese had done to our Parish by waiving off our long standing loan taken for the new school construction. Hence, we are all the more obliged to turn in our mint. And so, I request all those who have not contributed till this date to consider prayerfully sending their contribution to meet the given goal so that our Parish will be in good stead with the diocese for future support.

Home and School meeting: The second Home and School meeting was held on January 8, Tuesday at 6.45 pm. It was attended by some well-meaning parents of our school. Karen Harms from the Financial Council was present to clarify the doubts concerning the receipts and payments of the annual fundraisers and school lunch program. When she gave the actual numbers of the said programs, it really opened the eyes of those present. It was evident from the figures she presented that our school lunch program is run on 'no profit no loss' basis. She also said that what the fund raisers bring in is mighty little vis- a - vis the good chunk of the money that is spent on running the Parish School with considerably low numbers on the roll. Josh Vandike informed the group that the school computer systems have been upgraded and relevant educational software program installed. The Pastor in his comments highlighted the negative tendency that is growing among the parents which is impacting the growth of the kids. He referred to a study that was conducted some years ago revealed that by the time the kids come up to the age of three, they would have received 300 different negative messages. Such phenomenon is detrimental for the kids to develop positive self-image and will further lead them to lack in self - confidence and taking initiatives. So as to address this issue, a program will be given for the 5th to the 8th graders to make them aware of what they are and enable them to develop a positive self-image.

Faculties meeting: A meeting was held with the faculties of the school on January 10, Thursday after school. It was meant for chalking out some ways of sharing different responsibilities of the school with the principal. Alongside, a number of programs were discussed and finalized – one of them was to form a school choir to lead the singing at school Mass and the other was to do school Mass on a Sunday once in every quarter. The school also will work on an exhibition to highlight what our kids have done during the school year.

School Board Meeting: It was held on January 10, Thursday at 6 pm. It was mainly to go over the budget proposals prepared by the Principal under the direction of Karen Harms for the year 2019 – 2020. The members also made some suggestions as to how to increase the strength in the school.

Catholic Schools Week: It has been scheduled for January 27 – February 1. This year, the theme has been – **learn, serve, lead and succeed**. The start off Mass will be on January 27 at 8 am. Each day has got a program planned and you will be informed about it. And so, I invite all parents to join the proposed program of the school and encourage our school faculties, staff and students by your presence. Please remember it is our parish school and it is a major ministry of the parish. Hence, I would look forward to seeing a good turnout at least on the opening day.
