## From the Pastor:

**Italian Feast:** It was wonderful program to bring parents, kids and well –wishers together on a common goal of supporting our school with time, talents and treasures. It was indeed a wonderful gesture manifested on the day of event on February 2<sup>nd</sup>, Saturday evening. I extend a big thank you to the organizers who did put in a great deal of hard work to get delicious food, silent auction and wine testing and brought the event to a success. The involvement of school family was quite noteworthy most particularly of our school kids readily attending to the needs of the people eating at each table. It is a good Christian education.

**A big thank you:** During the catholic school week, I had a chance to talk to the kids on the beautiful gift of priestly vocation and of religious life which our diocese is in greater need. I did realize that most of the kids had no idea about what it is to be a priest or religious. Perhaps, they do not get it home or elsewhere. Here is where I feel the need of some religion classes at School and PSR as well so that they will have some idea to think about. I do thank all the faculties for giving me a chance to interact with our kids on vocation. On this day, I was honored with bundle of hand - made appreciation cards with beautiful drawings and a big basket containing fruits, snacks, bottled water and gift cards by the faculties & staff and kids. I appreciate them so much for their kind gesture of remembering me on vocation day. I do pray that they all grow in wisdom and knowledge day by day and bring forth their best for the good of the school, parish and church.

**Eucharistic Adoration:** Our Parish has been blessed to have Eucharistic Adoration on every First Friday starting at 8 am and going up to midnight. It is a very powerful devotion that has been quite profound in the Church. It is a time one spends with the Lord either in silence or in prayer. He is inviting us ‘come to me all you who labor and are burdened I will give you rest’. The presence of Jesus permeates the entire church which cannot be explained but it has to be experienced. A gentle man under church improvement project in Eldon told me, Father, ‘it is so peaceful out here in the Chapel.’ This is not the first time I have heard such good news. How the Good Lord fills the persons with His peace! I do appreciate all those participate in the Eucharistic adoration on a regular basis. What I hear the same pair of people sign up and show up for such devotion. Hence, I invite others who have not been yet to taste how good the Lord is, please give a try. Every one of us has got too many things going on. In the midst of all that I suggest that you make it as your monthly schedule to spend an hour with the Lord. When husband and wife are praying together, it makes immense difference in their married life as well as their family life. More so, if their kids are with them, they will also learn to spend time with the Lord. Even other times, you can walk in and spend some time with the Lord during the day or night as our church is open twenty - four - seven. Betty Pound was kind enough to get a light with timer at the sanctuary that burns whole night.

**Feast of St. Valentine:** The feast of St. Valentine falls on February 14. It is to honor the saint who went against the order of Emperor Claudius who had banned all marriages in 269 AD. Because, the Emperor wanted to have a big army for which he made it compulsory for all the youth to join the military. Valentine was a priest then. He defied the order and started blessing the weddings of young couples in secret with candlelight. One day as he was performing a marriage ceremony, he was caught and imprisoned. While he was in prison, many young folk who received marriage blessing threw flowers and notes of appreciation through his prison window as they walked by. One of these young people was the daughter of the prison guard. With the permission of her dad, she visited with him in his prison cell. She would sit and talk for hours and thus helped him to keep his spirits alive. This went on for a while. Finally, the day before he was going to be executed, he left her a little note thanking her for her friendship and loyalty signing it as, “**Love from your Valentine.**” In the recent years, the business world has made it ‘**lovers’ day** making all kinds of gifts and cards available. Now the younger generation not knowing the real meaning of Christian love is blindly carried away by glamorous things of the market. It is a love with sacrifice which is selfless. It always and everywhere seeks the good and wellbeing of others. I wish and pray that we all may understand the true meaning this love revealed by Jesus which inspired Saints like St. Valentine.
