From the Pastor:

As we live in the midst of different churches, I thought I would share the following information on how different churches got originated over the years from the one Holy and Apostolic Church founded by Jesus Christ.

Lutheran church: started by Fr. Martin Luther in Germany in 1517.

Mennonite church: (split with Martin Luther and John Calvin) started by Menno Simons in Switzerland in 1525.

Anglican church: started by King Henry VIII in England in 1534.

Presbyterian church: started by John Knox in Scotland in 1560.

Congregational church: started by Robert Brown, in Holland in 1582.

Baptist church: started by John Smith in Amsterdam in 1606.

Methodist church: started by John Murray in New Jersey in 1770.

Episcopalian church: (off-shoot of the Anglican church) started by Samuel Seabury in American colonies in 1789.

Mormon Church: (also known as the church of Latter Day Saints) started by Joseph Smith in New York in 1829.

Seventh Day Adventist: started by William Miller in US in 1831.

Salvation Army: started by William Booth in London in 1865.

Jehovah's Witness: started by Charles Russell in US in 1872.

Assemblies of God: (a Pentecostal denomination) started by Charles Parham in USA in 1914

Redeemed Christian church of God: started by Josiah Akindayomi in Nigeria in 1952.

Deeper Life Bible Church: started by Pastor William Kumuyi in Lagos in Nigeria 1973.

Mountain of Fire: started by Dr. Daniel Olukoya in Nigeria in 1989.

Other Denominations: the church of the Nazarene, Pentecostal Gospel, Holiness church and others came into existence as years rolled by. We can go on and on with the list and that will become too large. Apart from the Catholic Church, every other ecclesia assembly (church) was founded by a human being.
