From the Pastor:

Parish Mission: It is our annual Lenten spiritual preparation. This time, it is not a lengthy one starting on March 13th, Wednesday for three evenings running to 45 minutes each. On the last day, March 15th, Friday, it might go a little longer as we have got communal penance service. It will be worthwhile investing our valuable time for this spiritual renewal program.

Abstinence: It is recommended that we abstain from eating meat on Fridays during lent. It also invites us to make sacrifice of the things we like most. I know there are many people who abstain from smoking, drinking and other habits during the 40 days of lent. It is one of the ways to discipline our lives in order to grow in self-control.

Freerice.com: It is a program promoted by the World Food Organization inviting kids and adults to work toward alleviating the world hunger. It is wonderful Lenten program like rice bowl. What you need to do is to log on to freerice.com. Then you will find different programs popping up such as Humanities, Math, Language learning, Sciences, English vocabulary, Game, Chemistry, Geography and Test Preparations and so forth. Now, you can click on the subject you like most and work on it. If you answer any one correctly, you will add 10 food grains to the granary of WFO. It is a wing of United Nations Organization that has its headquarters in Rome. I generally work on English vocabulary which is quite fascinating. The objective of the said program is **‘play, learn and feed the hungry.** According to the latest information by WFO – **‘every day too many men and women across the globe struggle to feed their children a nutritious meal. In a world where we produce enough food to feed everyone, there are 795 million people – one in nine – still go to bed an empty stomach each night. Even more – one in three – suffer from some form of malnutrition’.** You can get more details from World Food Program’s website.
