From the Pastor:

The Lord has risen! He has risen indeed Halleluiah. Joining with the entire Church and the world, we rejoice over the great wonder of God who raised Jesus from the dead and opened the door to eternal home for the entire humanity. Thus we have become the faith-filled and hope - filled people of God. I extend you all **His 'Shalom'** a Hebrew word that signifies the all embracing gift of God which is immensely richer than the English word 'Peace' May this gift of Easter envelope you all and your family members!

I would like to highlight an important feast that the Church celebrates on Sunday, April 28 after Easter. It is called **Divine Mercy Sunday** started by St. John Paul II in the year 2000. It was done in response to the request made by Jesus to St. Faustina in one of His several apparitions to her since 1931 in Poland. She wrote down all that Jesus told her during His apparitions and that became a voluminous book titled '**the diary of Sr. Faustina**'. What touched me most reading the diary is that Jesus has made a number of amazing promises. I refer to one of the most touching promises mentioned in NO.699 in her diary. It reads '**my daughter, tell the whole world about my inconceivable mercy. I desire that the Feast of mercy be a refuge and shelter for all souls, and especially for poor sinners. On that day, the very depths of my tender mercy are open. I pour out a whole ocean of graces upon those souls who approach the fount of my mercy. The souls that will go to confession, and receive Holy Communion on this day shall obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishments**' Further NO.13 reads '**I promise that the soul that will venerate this image [divine mercy] will not perish. I also promise victory over its enemies already here on earth, especially at the hour of death, I myself will defend it as my own glory**'. I picked up this devotion while I was in England in the year 2000. Since then, I have been following it and promoting it in the Parishes I have worked. Really and truly, it has brought down immense blessings upon me and upon all those who have faithfully followed it.

The Novena to the feast of Divine Mercy starts on Good Friday and ends on Saturday before the feast. We will make a folder titled '**Divine Mercy Novena and Chaplet**' available to everyone as soon as we get it. I wish and pray that most of you will follow it and receive the blessings that Jesus has promised. I consider that this devotion is one of the best means to get peace and harmony in families and communities. We have given in the bulletin insert more details on St. Faustina, and how to do the Divine Mercy Chaplet.

Holy Water containers will be available for you take the holy water blessed on Easter Vigil which is considered very special to bless your houses and use it in time of sickness and other needs.

I take a moment to say '**a big thank you**' to all who helped out with different ministries on Holy Thursday, Good Friday and Easter Vigil services. May the Risen Lord keep you all happy and joyful in His vineyard!
