From the Pastor:

Graduation Mass: I was pleased to have four high school graduating students of our parish, Cody Schulte & Madison Evers of Helias High School and Ethan Adrian & Cameron Haeffner of Eugene Public School along with their parents at Mass on last Sunday to receive special blessings. It was a time they needed our prayerful support as they stepped in to a new phase of life with all its challenges. I had wished we had more students showed up. Once again, I thank Carol Plank for getting them together and thus began a good practice in our parish.

New Principal: By God's grace and the intercession of Blessed Mother, we have been blessed to have a new Principal by name Jacob Akin, a qualified and skilled person. He was recommended by the Search Committee which consisted of Roselyn Wood and Jason Bittle (School Board) and Paula Evers (Pastoral Council) after an interview held on May 15th led by Sr. Julie from the Education Office. Subsequently, after some consideration, a contract was offered and signed on May 19th to be effective from July 1, 2019 through June 30, 2020. I thank the committee members and Sr. Julie for their kind and timely assistance in helping me to take a right decision for the good and future of our School. On behalf of the Parish, I extend Mr. Jake a warm welcome and wish him well in his new challenging ministry in our parish school.

Many thanks: Perhaps you all have known that Mrs. Kathleen Haeffner resigned from being a teacher in our school for some family related reason. She has served our school nearly 8 years and has been considered one of the best teachers in our school. On behalf the parish, I thank her immensely for the commendable services that she has done to our school and parish over the years. May the Lord continue to bless her and guide her through!

Amazing Race: It was a joy-filled and fun-filled program with a lot of excitement done on May 16th by our school faculties and kids with the support of some parish volunteers and the 8th grade graduated students. The whole school was divided into 7 groups with a faculty to head each group. Each group had to tour to 10 spots to do activities that was designated. Besides, our school ground, the church, the local bank, credit union, corner market were also included in the tour spots. At corner market, each group was welcomed with ice cream which was sponsored by an anonymous donor. It took a while for each group to complete the activities by visiting all the 10 spots. Although the group led by Mr. Vandike came first, Rosie Beck, the coordinator declared the group led by Ms. Grellner as the winner because she had accepted 11 kids in to her group while others had 10 each. Finally, it was also time to mingle with all kids from pre-school to 7th grades. This program was planned and organized by Mrs. Massman and I thank her immensely for taking such wonderful initiative.

Graduation day: On May 17th, Friday, the last day of the school, 10 of our Pre-school kids received their graduation over at the well-organized School Award Ceremony held in the school gymnasium. They are all lively kids who give me very prompt and good response to my homilies at School Mass. Truly, Ms. Miranda Voss made them smart in a year of her hard work and I thank her for her dedicated services.

A new grant for our school: The Miller County Health Department has given a grant of \$ 17,487.00 to our school called Miller County Health Wellness grant. It is meant to provide new kids playground equipment. It was result of the hard work put in by Mr. Josh and I thank him for his wonderful service to our school.

Summer vacation: It is a God-given time for our kids and so they need to spend it well with meaningful activities. It will be the responsibility of their parents to keep them engaged. They also need to encourage them to attend summer programs and camps organized by the diocese and others. With the usual household duties, a summer schedule could be drawn up which will be of great help for both the parents and kids to monitor and follow them. I wish all our kids a meaningful and enjoyable summer vacation.

Dress Code: As the weather is getting warmer and warmer day by day, people tend to dress up lightly. However, I would like all liturgical ministers, such as lectors and Eucharistic ministers to dress up moderately so that they do not draw the attention of the congregation that should be given to the Eucharistic celebration. At Mass, the Word of God and Eucharistic celebration should be our focus and so we, as a congregation must help each other to be focused avoiding all kinds of distraction that would take the main attention from Mass.

Installation of AED (Automated External Defibrillator): Perhaps you all know that we have been awarded a free AED unit by Miller County Health Department through Eldon Ministerial Alliance for our Church which has been mounted on the right side wall in the cry room. I extend my thanks to MCHD and EMA for considering and supporting the need of our Church attendees. AED is used to treat victims who experience sudden cardiac arrest (SCA). It is only to be applied to a victim who is unconscious, not breathing normally and showing no signs of circulation, such as normal breathing, coughing and movement. The AED will analyze the heart rhythm and advice the operator if a shockable rhythm is detected. If a shockable rhythm is detected, AED will charge to the appropriate energy level and advice the operator to deliver the shock. The authorized AED users are parishioners who have successfully completed CPR/AED training. They are Bryan and Paula Evers. If no trained parishioner is present, any bystander acting in good faith is authorized to use the AED. Other trained medical professionals are also authorized to use the AED. Becky Schwaller will be the project contact person and will be responsible for maintenance checks. I thank them and wish them all well.

On **Memorial Day**, we gratefully remember all men and women who have died in military service. May God grant them eternal rest and their families be comforted and supported.
