Now it is time for our newly confirmed to face the challenges of the secular world. Being strengthened in Faith by the sacrament, I would like them stay connected with the church to grow stronger in faith and to take up different ministries at Mass which will help them exercise their time and talent for the good of the community.

**Totus Tuus Program:** Totus Tuus is a Latin phrase meaning **“totally yours.”** This was the motto of Pope John Paul II taken from St. Louis de Montfort’s True Devotion to Mary. It signifies our desire to give ourselves entirely to Jesus Christ through Mary while preparing our younger generation to grow towards it.

This has been a summer program in many dioceses in United States including ours. It is a wonderful program designed both for the lower graders (1- 6) and upper graders (7 – 12). The Kindergarten kids also will be part of the program with different activities of their level.

In the diocese, year after year more parishes are added to this program and so now it is run almost all the parishes where we have got kids. By God’s grace, we started it in our parish last year and the attendance was quite encouraging. We are looking forward to have bigger attendance this year as it is starting on **June 9<sup>th</sup> running up to the 14<sup>th</sup>**.

Hence, I request all parents who have been blessed with wonderful kids to register their names for the program. I would not like any of our kids be left out of it. Because, it is a God-given time for them to learn more about faith, sacraments, saints, church, prayers and new songs filled with interesting activities. **Natural Disaster:** As announced at last weekend Masses, I would like to continue the appeal for donations and volunteers to help out the people who have been impacted by tornadoes and flooding. **The following is the message given by the Bishop:**

We continue to pray for all who are impacted by the natural disasters this year, both the tornadoes that hit Cole, Hickory, Miller and Randolph counties this past week, and the flooding of major rivers in our Diocese. Counties impacted by that flooding include Boone, Callaway, Camden, Chariton, Clark, Cole, Gasconade, Howard, Lewis, Linn, Maries, Marion, Miller, Moniteau, Monroe, Montgomery, Morgan, Osage, Pettis, Phelps, Perry, Pike, Ralls, Randolph and Saline.

Catholic Charities of Central and Northern Missouri, an agency of our Diocese, is working with other agencies to ensure a coordinated and integrated network of support is provided to those affected. If you or your parish group would like to volunteer, please contact United Way at 2-1-1. It is serving as the central clearinghouse to match immediate needs with resources.

As Catholic Charities did in response to the 2017 floods, it is putting in place a process to assist those who have a very fragile safety net: people without insurance, who are not homeowners, on limited income, with disabilities, or whose livelihood has been impacted by the natural disaster. If you are interested in assisting in this effort, please consider donating to Catholic Charities’ Disaster Relief Fund.
