From the Pastor:

As we are celebrating the feast of the Immaculate Heart Mary this Sunday on June 30, the Patroness of our diocese, I would like give you a brief on the origin of the devotion to Immaculate Heart of Mary in the Church.

This devotion began to spread during the 17th and 18th centuries. It was St. John Eudes who popularized this devotion along with devotion to the Sacred Heart of Jesus in France. Then, when Blessed Mother appeared to the three shepherd children at Fatima in 1917, she expressed the desire of God to establish in the world a devotion to her Immaculate Heart. In her Memoirs Lucia (one of the three) writes, “Our Lady told us, in the July secret, that God wished to establish in the world devotion to her Immaculate Heart.” Our Lady further said, *Jesus wishes you to make me known and loved on earth. He wishes also for you to establish devotion in the world to my Immaculate Heart.* Three times her Immaculate Heart was mentioned in that July apparition, also referring to the conversion of Russia and the vision of hell. Our Lady again said, *you have seen hell, where the souls of poor sinners go. It is to save them that God wants to establish in the world devotion to my Immaculate Heart.* She further describes that the blessed Virgin held in her hand a heart surrounded by thorns, which pierced it from all sides. It was the Immaculate Heart of Mary, afflicted by all the sins of the world, which called for penance and reparation. Finally the Blessed Virgin said, “It is through the Immaculate Heart of Mary that God wishes to grant graces. It is through the Immaculate Heart that we must ask for them. The Heart of Jesus wishes the Immaculate Heart of Mary to be venerated with His own.

After the revelations, the children were true models of devotion and reparation to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. They loved this Heart ardently, invoked it constantly, spoke about it enthusiastically. They multiplied penances to console it and make reparation for all the blasphemies that cause it suffer. As regards Russia, our Lady asked that it be consecrated to her Immaculate Heart. She also wanted them to tell the Pope then to all the Bishops to have it done on one special day:” if it is not done, the errors of Russia will spread through every country in the world.”

Finally Blessed Mother desired that all faithful to recite rosary daily and have devotion to her Immaculate Heart. Indeed, the **Immaculate Heart of Mary** is a **devotional** name used to refer to the interior life of the Blessed Virgin **Mary**, her joys and sorrows, her virtues and hidden perfections, and, above all, her virginal love for God the Father, her maternal love for her son Jesus, and her compassionate love for all people.

In response to her request, Pope Pius XII dedicated all mankind to the Immaculate Heart of Mary on 8th December 1942 as the world was in the grip of the Second World War. By a decree of the Sacred Congregation of Rites on May 4, 1944, this feast was introduced into the calendar of the universal church. By instituting the feast, the Pope sincerely hoped that through Mary’s intercession all nations would receive peace and the Church of Christ blessing of freedom. Mary’s sorrow – filled soul experiences all the suffering that can weigh upon all mankind, while her compassionate and motherly heart is able to comfort and strengthen her children in the Kingdom of her Divine Son. I would highly appreciate your cooperation in this regard so that we can worship God in good spirit and prayerful atmosphere.

Ministry to the sick and homebound: We are blessed to have several dedicated persons doing wonderful ministry by reaching Holy Communion to the sick and the homebound. However, I would like to organize it well so that all those who desire Holy Communion are covered. For this, I intend to make list of ministers with some details as to whom, when and where they serve. Therefore, I request all those who are doing this ministry to call the office and give your names with the requested details. After we have collected the names, I would like to have a meeting with them to refresh the importance of such ministry and how well it can be done. On emergency or anyone in your family needs visits by the Pastor or Holy Communion, please contact the parish office.

Independence Day: I extend to each and every one of you a **Happy Independence Day** on July 4. May the God continue to bless our nation and people to work toward building up one nation under God.
