From the Pastor:

Volunteers for PSR Classes: Most of our ministries in the Parish are run by a good number of generous people who readily give their time, talent and treasures. PSR program is one of them. It would be possible to run it well only when we are to have enough teachers to step in to give their time and talents. We have made repeated appeal over at the last couple of weekend Masses for volunteers to take classes in 7 & 8 and 10 grades and subs. Parents who have got some teaching experience and others who have done some classes must consider the appeal prayerfully for the good of the children of our parish. They will be guided with teaching materials and personal support.

Funeral Service Procedure: When someone has died in a family, the family concerned generally contacts the funeral Home. Then through Funeral Home, the particular family meets with the Pastor to plan out for the funeral details (visitation, Mass, readings, music, and other ministries). This helps the Pastor to get to know the diseased person & the family and to make the homily personal. For some reason or other, this procedure has been overlooked. The only information that the pastor gets is from the obituary prepared by the Funeral Home which is generally too brief. I would like this set procedure be followed to avoid all kinds of misunderstanding. There are families who still do follow the set procedure and make sure that the Pastor is aware of the funeral that is being planned.

Funeral Visitation: I would like to bring to the knowledge of everyone about the matter that was printed in the bulletin on July 28. It reads under the heading of Appreciation: “In response to my appeal at last weekend Masses for maintaining silence in the church before and after Mass has been received well and responded positively. I appreciate you all for your kind gesture of cooperation in our collective church discipline. After Saturday Mass, an active member of our parish met with me and said that we need to discourage visitation in the church on funerals which can be done in the hall of Knights of Columbus or in the funeral home. Eldon started doing it in the funeral home after it has been told to the funeral home people. It has been told to them if anyone so desires visitation in the church then strict silence has to be maintained and so now no one opts for it.” Now this text has been misinterpreted and acted upon as a decision to hold funeral visitation in the KC hall. In this text, I had only made a reference to the decision taken by Eldon. I have written to the Diocese asking whether there has been a policy in place on visitation being held in the church. Until I get some definite information from the diocese, when there will be a funeral done, I would like the family concerned to contact me either directly or indirectly through Parish Office or funeral Home.

My apologies: I extend my humble apologies to the family members, relatives and well - wishers of late Jim Boessen for the inconvenience and ill - feelings that had caused them over his funeral visitation and non-availability of school gym for funeral luncheon. In spite of all inconveniences, God had blessed him and his family with a big funeral. May his soul rest in peace!

A request: Whenever anyone should find difficulties in understanding both my written and spoken English, please feel free to get clarified. Because, communication channel involves at one end a **sender** and at the other end a **receiver** with **medium** in between which would be the language and other aids of communication. In order to get the correct message when it is communicated, one has to have open mind and listening heart tuned in within context.

Mini – Mission: There will be a mini – mission program held in our Parish on October 29th and 30th starting at 6.30 pm. We are getting four speakers to do it both in Mary’s Home and Eldon with two speakers each at one place for each evening. The details will be given later. Meanwhile, please keep these dates marked on your calendar.
