What's the process for the Pastoral Plan?

During Lent, the small faith-sharing groups will meet for four sessions. The groups will be asked to consider how their stewardship requires a co-responsibility between laity and clergy to enliven their parish as a center of charity and mercy. They will be asked to submit a Discernment Report at the end of each session to their pastor. The pastor and pastoral council will use these reports to develop a parish pastoral plan. In turn, the diocesan team will receive the parish pastoral plans and develop a diocesan pastoral plan from those plans.

After affirmation by the Diocesan Pastoral Council and the Diocesan Presbyteral Council, the diocesan pastoral plan will be promulgated by Advent 2020.
